


We know school holidays can be busy, exhausting, and sometimes a little overwhelming for parents. That's why Playtime Pioneers has created this free Easter Activity Book.

Just a small way for us to support families and make the holidays a little easier (and more fun!)




Hanging Easter Eggs





Materials:

MAKE YOUR OWN BUNNY EARS



1. Print this page.

4. Tape the bands together to make one long band. Then, connect both ends with tape to go around the top of your head. (Adjust and make more bands if needed.)
5. Tape the ears behind the part of the band that goes on your forehead.
